### Tucson High Magnet Teachers will:

### Tucson High Magnet Students will:

- Regularly communicate with the teacher regarding questions and concerns.
- Turn in all homework and class assignments on-time.
- Maintain excellent attendance and dedicate time each day to reinforce learned concepts.

## Parents' Right To Know

As a parent of a student in the Tucson Unified School District, you have a right to know the professional qualifications of the teachers who in-struct your child. You have the right to ask for the following information about each of your child's classroom teachers:

- ▯ Whether the State of Arizona has licensed or qualified the teacher for the grades and subject he or she teaches.
- ▯ Whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency permit or other provisional status by which state licensing criteria have been waived.
- ▯ The teacher's college major; whether the teacher has any advanced degrees and, if so, the subject of the degrees.
- ▯ Whether any instructional aides or similar paraprofessionals provide services to your child and, if they do, their qualifications.
