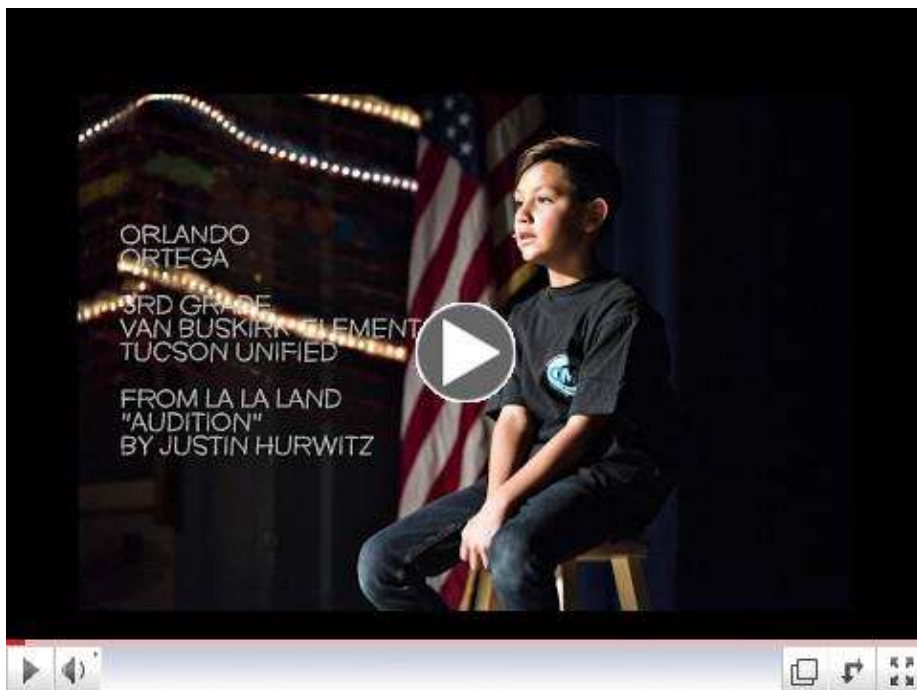


## Catch up with Brianna, member of Tucson High's #ClassOf2020
