


#### Are you ready for some #TUSDSports?

#### Info about teacher pay raises

Are you a teacher who is wondering how to see your \$2,000 pay raise?

Below, we have included steps 1-11 of the 2015-2016 and the 2016-2017 teacher salary schedules side-by-side as an example. Because returning teachers received a step increase, they should compare their 2015-2016 step with one step higher on the 2016-2017 salary schedule to see the \$2,000 raise.

The 2016-2017 teacher salary schedule approved by the Governing Board on June 28, 2016, can be reviewed <u>here</u>. Questions? Call Payroll at 225-6150 or check with Employee Relations at 225-6739.

Note: All eligible employees who are not teachers received a 2 percent increase this year.
