



Are you ready for some #TUSDsports?

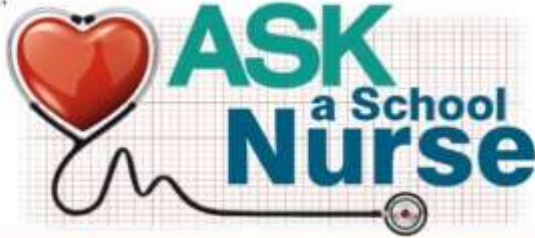

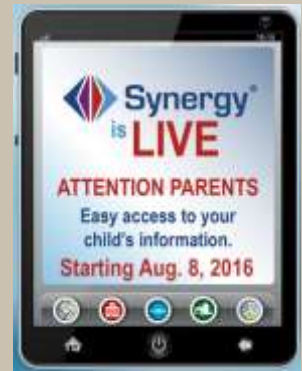
State seeks input on proposed revisions to learning standards
