




Using Guest Wi-Fi at Tucson Unified

- 1. Before you can use the Guest Wi-Fi network at Tucson Unified School District, a district administrator must request access on your behalf.
- 2. It is recommended that the request for access to Guest Wi-Fi be made at least 48 hours in advance of your visit. We cannot guarantee immediate access at the last minute.
- 3. Your contact at the district needs to request access for you by creating a <u>Guest Wi-Fi Request ticket in the Jira self-service portal</u> or by calling Technology Services at 225-6262, ext. #3.
- Your district contact must fill out all available fields in the Jira ticket at the above link.
 Alternately, if you have a large group of people needing Guest Wi-Fi access, please have your contact fill out the <u>Large Group Request Form Guest Wi-Fi</u>. Then, have them attach it to the Jira ticket.
- 5. When your account has been created, you will receive an email message from donotreply@tusd1.org; it will contain your username and password for access to the district Guest Wi-Fi.



- 6. On your device, select **TUSD Guest** as the network you want to join.
- 7. The Guest Portal sign-on screen will appear. Enter the username and password that were emailed to you. Then Click **Sign On**.


